



The objective of a Banner Raid is to provide a FUN experience for both clubs involved. Visiting Club Members often take many great ideas back to their home clubs, which in

turn promotes healthy, strong, creative Toastmasters clubs throughout our District.

To ensure this is done in the spirit of "fun-ness," here are a few guidelines:

Raiding Club will contact the "target" club and ask permission to visit, indicating the intent of doing a Banner Raid.

Target Club will make an effort to include one or two "Raiders" in roles during the meeting.

If Raiding Club brings five or more members to the meeting, the Target Club's banner will be forfeited to the Raiders.

Target Club may retrieve their banner by going through the same process listed above. If they bring ten club members to retrieve their banner, they can also steal the other club's banner!

If the Target Club is unable to retrieve their banner within four weeks, the banner will automatically be returned to them.

No club with fewer than 10 members should be raided. Instead, consider a joint meeting with lots of idea-sharing!

District 25 will award Club Raider Ribbons to "Raiding" Clubs. No proof is needed... these ribbons are awarded on-your-honor. Photographs of the Banner Raid are encouraged!
